CLASS 1: Class one have had a very enjoyable week with a great experience at Tullie House where we were able to see and play with old toys. Through the toys topic we have learned more about materials and how modern toys tend to be made from different plastics, whereas older toys were made from pot, wood and metals such as tin or steel. We have also looked at things that have been alive or never alive- try this with items around your home. Y1 have continued using the part whole model to find fact families and number bonds in maths.

CLASS 2: This week class 2 have had fun investigating how toys work and how they have changed through the years on our trip to Tullie House. In maths we have been using our toys in a toy shop to work out totals and amounts of change.

CLASS 3: This week class 3 have been super busy. We have continued to explore our topic and looked at some of the key composers of the Baroque and classical periods. The children collected notes and we started to piece together a poster. We have looked at using parts of word on the laptops and how to save our work. The children used oil pastels and practiced techniques to create texture and blending. We will use these skills in further art work. Class 3 continue to use their place value skills to subtract, exchanging and exploring different ways to do this, remembering the top number must be larger. Keep up the good work class 3!

CLASS 4: This week in class 4 we have been really busy and we have written song lyrics and preformed them. On Wednesday afternoon Mrs. Oakes visited us. She worked with us on our music and our art, she was very impressed with our work. We have also learned about four and six figure grid references and used a range of maps as well as a model landscape to test our mapping skills. We would like to welcome Miss Gearing who has joined our class yesterday as our new Teaching assistant apprentice.
