**CLASS 1:** A very busy week, with everyone now on task with their phonics (Please look for homework in their bags) In maths, reception children have been finding out all about one and the oneness of a number, whilst year 1 have been counting objects accurately from random groups. We have been looking at Florence Nightingale and understanding how she influenced hygiene in hospitals, set up nurse training and women working. In Science we are looking at differences between the seasons. When you are out and about, draw your child's attention to the colour changes we witness during Autumn

**CLASS 2:** This week class 2 have been thinking about firefighters and how they help us. We have written about how the fire service began after the Great Fire of London in 1666. We have grouped firefighters in tens and calculated word problems linked to the fire officers for our column addition and subtraction. We enjoyed playing London's burning on the keyboards and singing the song as a round. In Geography we found London on google maps and wrote in the UK capital cities on a map of the UK.

**CLASS 3:** This week class 3 have had a bust week as we have discussed the role of trees in the ecosystem and how they help us. The children have used ICT skills to research various famous trees around the world and compared how they have grown to their environment. The children continue to find information about Harvest festival and have made our own corn dollies, and have reused and upcycled newspaper and magazines to make new sculptures.

**CLASS 4:** This week in Class 4 we have been learning how to hold and play the note 'B' on the recorder. We learned and played 2 new songs together and with hardly a squeaky note! In Art, we have begun to study the work of Henry Matisse and put together our own pieces in the Fauvism style. We are excited about our 'animal tail' day on Wednesday next week, and are planning lots of science activities that we can carry out on the day.
