Class 2: We have really enjoyed “machines” as our theme for learning about- full stops and capitals, commas in lists, theatre reviews, letter writing layout, poetry's rhythm, performing poetry, sequencing connectives, paragraphs and our weekly spelling patterns. In maths we enjoyed exploring function machines, column addition, times tables with word problems, greater than symbol, place value and much more. Next half term we will be using INVADERS as our theme to deliver the content of the statutory national Curriculum, whilst also having the flexibility to also branch out where the pupil's curiosity takes us.
