Class 1 This week we have been estimating in maths. We've been doing lots of practical estimating with all sorts of equipment around the classroom. Y2 were linking their times table knowledge to working out how many windows there were in a huge building. Allow your child over the weekend to have guesses of how many items there are in the fridge or cupboard, then count them. The infants have produced lovely pictures of art from around the world within their art topic, look out for their work on the display boards.

Class 2 This week class 2 have been learning how to write biographies using paragraphs. We have been inspired by the character and achievements of Mary Seacole and Isambard Kingdom Brunel. Please ask your child what "legacy" means, and what the legacies are, of these famous Victorians. In maths we have been measuring the capacity of containers and reading scales with different "jumps". We have also been measuring the area of circles and enjoying investigating circles. Have a go at this one....use a piece of string to measure the distance around the outside of a circle. Draw a line exactly through the middle and measure this. How many times does the middle go around the outside of the circle? Try it with different sized circles....is there a pattern or rule?

Class 3 This week the juniors have been learning about punctuation in English (it was really fun). In maths, the year 6's have been learning about formulae, the year 5's have been learning about decimals and the year 4's have been learning about converting kilometres into metres. The year 6's have also been practising for their SATs (Standard Attainment Tests) We are all looking forward to our Beamish trip next week!!! Written by Lucy, Graydon and Macie
