Class 1 The reception pupils have been using Numicon in their maths to make groups of 10 and for adding and subtraction. They have been playing maths games such as Dominos and Snakes and Ladders with the Year 1's, who have also been counting in 10's, 5's and 2's and also making equal and unequal groups. In English the pupils have been writing Stickman's letter home to his family and thinking how to improve their writing.
