School will be funding the cost of this trip. **Children will need a packed lunch please.**

We are learning about rationing and we even tried homemade jam on toast (made by Miss Lawson) and next week we will be cooking some war time recipes. We are also really excited about going on our evacuee trip next week to the beacon on our train.
