## GENERAL REMINDERS

**Sports Day** Sports day is planned for Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> July and, weather permitting we will begin at 1.30.p.m. If the weather is poor we will be having it on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> July. Please assume that the event **will** go ahead unless you hear to the contrary. If the weather is not suitable; a decision will be made at 9.30 on the morning of the event based on the BBC hourly weather forecast. We will then text you to let you know if it is cancelled. So, if you **do not** receive a text it **will** be going ahead. We expect to finish at 3.10p.m. but we may run over. Please collect children from the rugby club on Sports day afternoon. If children are staying for Happy Hours we will bring them up to school for their Happy Hours session. They will need sun cream on, sun hat/cap and a coat in case it turns colder. Please could you ensure they have their P.E. kit (navy blue T-shirt, black or blue shorts and tracksuit bottoms with trainers that have a good grip) .We will be providing coloured ribbons this year so no need to send in coloured T-shirts as they look smarter in their school P.E.kits. They should come to school in normal uniform and we will get changed after lunch. Choc-ices will be available for 50p (for children and grown-ups) to purchase.

**School Uniform** We are having supply issues with Tesco in regards to the school uniform ordering service. We are delighted that we have now got an on-line link to our original suppliers, Identity. This enables the parents to order and pay for their orders and have them delivered to school for collection. (The company is hoping to have it set up in October so that the delivery will come to your homes directly). The address is [www.oneidentity.co.uk](http://www.oneidentity.co.uk) , you will need to register your details, then they will send you a link to your email, which you will need to click on to activate, then they will set up an account for you which will take up to 48 hours to activate, then after that you can place your order and it will be delivered to school for your collection. You can order the round neck sweatshirt, the cardigan, white polo shirt (with school logo), the P.E.top, the P.E.bag, the book bag and the back pack. The trousers, pinafores and skirts can be purchased from your preferred retailer. (Grey or Black)

**Footwear** Next year the children will be using 'step counters' to improve activity rates for pupils so we are recommending the children wear plain-ish trainers rather than school shoes. This will mean they can run and do activities during play times without having to change their shoes or worry about forgetting their trainers for P.E. sessions.
