**CLASS 1** This week Class 1 have been working super hard. We have continued to practice our phonics skills by mixing and blending our new sounds and recalling our previous graphemes. We have been practicing our pencil grip as we practice our letter formations. In Maths we have been comparing different amounts of objects and using our counting skills to check our reasoning. We have used mathematical language like more, less, larger, smaller, equal, the same as. In our outdoor Science we explored the garden to find materials to create our own leaf people, we looked at the different parts of the body and selected what leaf would fit best, used grass for texture and hair, as well as used cutting skills to adapt the materials. Well done Class 1!

CLASS 2 In class 2 this week we have been busy being very enthusiastic poets! We have written our own poems all about how much we love leaves. We've been using ambitious, interesting vocabulary and the results are wonderful. In maths we have been using the language more than, less than, fewer and greater so any opportunity to use these words at home would help!

**CLASS 3** A reminder, please could you check clothing and items that your child brought back from Hawes End. We are still missing a grey blue hoodie, pyjama bottoms and a torch. Thank you. In maths we are working with place values and comparing number then working out where the number would be on a number line. In English we have drafted our stories, written up the corrected version then using Word, typed them up. We had a visit to Lakes College and watched a science show on forces. It was very enjoyable and entertaining.

**CLASS 4** This week, in class 4, the children have been working on a Stone Age research project. Everyone has been busy preparing their interview scripts ready to perform in front of the green screen. On Wednesday afternoon all of the juniors went to see the REACT Science show at Lake College. It was great fun and everyone had a really good time.
