**CLASS 1:** The children are very excited about bonfire night. The children have all heard the story about the plot and y1 have sequenced it. We have also discussed firework safety. Y1 have revisited number lines in maths whilst reception children have been learning all about 4 and understanding the concept.

**CLASS 2:** This week we have been learning about seasonal festivals. We have explored why we have Halloween and its origins, why we have Diwali and the story of Rama and Sita as well as why we have bonfire night. We had our own tiny bonfire in the garden today. We had written sentences in our assemblies about spiritual unfairness and then burned the sentences as an act of supporting spiritual freedom. We wrote recipes and made chocolate coated apples. Then we split the chocolate into different parts to help us understand halves, thirds and quarters.



**CLASS 3:** This week class 3 have worked super hard. We have used our place value knowledge to begin adding and subtracting 3 digit numbers, remembering to carry any extra 10s. We have started to look at our new topic, History of music. We brainstormed ideas of what we would like to explore and started to look at continents and oceans, remembering a lot from last year. We had a super pe session as we explored different types of gymnastics, building our core skills. Well done class 3 keep up the good work.

In maths we have been doing bidmas and algebra as well as squared, cubed and prime numbers. As a treat for working so hard we have been making chocolate apples.
