**Class 1:** We are starting to get in the mood for Christmas... making paper chains, decorating a tree, writing letters to Santa and having a go at wrapping pretend presents. In Maths we have been chatting about words and ideas to do with time. All the children really impressed Mrs Heppell by how many of the first 25 high frequency words they could read independently.

In class one this week we have been busy in English learning about poetry. We have read lots of animal poems and have played some rhyming games. Ask your child to say a word and run through the alphabet making up lots of rhyme. In maths we have been learning about 2D and 3D shapes, we have sorted, named and found lots of them in the environment. Ask your child to look around at home and find 2D and 3D shapes using their names.

**Class 2:** This week in maths we have been learning about place value up to a quintillion when thinking about how many particles there are in a grain of sand. We have practised how to write a story as a column addition calculation. We have also been revisiting the 4 times table with word problems. In English we have written William Caxton and Tim B Lee's biographies and been reading and answering questions about one of our world's biggest machines- the Hadron Collider in CERN.

**Class 3:** In maths year 5 and 6 have been finding percentages and fractions of a number after finishing their work on perimeter and area. Year 4 have also worked hard on their area and perimeter problems too. In topic we have been looking at climate change. In science year 5 and 6 have consolidated their knowledge of forces and year 3 and 4 have looked at magnets and electromagnets.
