Class 1

A huge welcome to our new starters in Reception and we have had a fabulous start to the school's new year! Our new topic is 'all about me' in line with people who help us. In KS1 we have been writing number words- with Y2 extending into hundreds and beyond! Reception children have had lots of social interaction with all the children in class 1 and have impressed us with their ability to make friends.
