

Dear Parents and Carers,

We recently reviewed our Pupil Premium Strategy and revised our offer for pupils receiving Pupil Premium based on current funding and financial support received by the government. This is available to view on our website and details how the funding is spent as a school and what we budget for individuals. We are pleased to confirm that we will still offer the following in order to support our families over the next academic year:

- Each child receiving the Pupil Premium will be eligible to request a free uniform consisting of 2 plain polo shirts, grey skirt or trousers, a jumper or cardigan with the school logo and a P.E. t-shirt and shorts. Items can be requested via the office at any point in the year and may take up to 14 days to be delivered.
- Pupils will have subsidised access of 50% to the range of services provided by external staff such as Judo breakfast club or school music tuition.
- Parents who have booked children onto the Cumberland Council HAF holiday activities can apply for funding from the school to cover costs of transport to and from the activities.
- School trips (1 day) up to the value of £15 will be fully funded by the school, any costs above this will be requested by parents.
- School residential experiences, including those provided by Cumberland Council, will be offered at a 50% reduction rate for pupil premium families.
- All pupils can request a stationary pack and book set at the start of the academic year to support learning at home.
- Subsidised access to the range of wrap around care and after school clubs provided by school staff at the rate of £1.50 for the morning session and £3 for the afternoon session.
