Infants: The infants are very excited about our new topic on 'Space' and we have begun to look at our Solar System and the things in it. In maths we have investigated 3d shapes and have begun to be familiar with the vocabulary around properties of shapes. We have been thinking about their edges, face and vertices (corners) and which shapes tessellate (fit together without gaps)



We also particularly enjoyed learning about the moon and class 2 have been watching how the phases of the moon appear to change shape. Class 2 have also been measuring in degrees Celsius and also measuring in cms.

Juniors This week the juniors have been thoroughly inspired by Jeff Wayne's music and lyrics and H.G.Wells' book 'The War of The Worlds'. They have used their comprehension skills whilst interpreting the text and drawn images of the Martians, their machinery and their journey to earth. They have also carried out the new 'Terrific Scientific' investigation about feet and submitted their results to help scientists at the University of Kent. We have found we have flexible feet!!

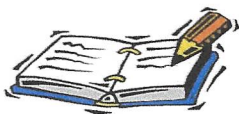

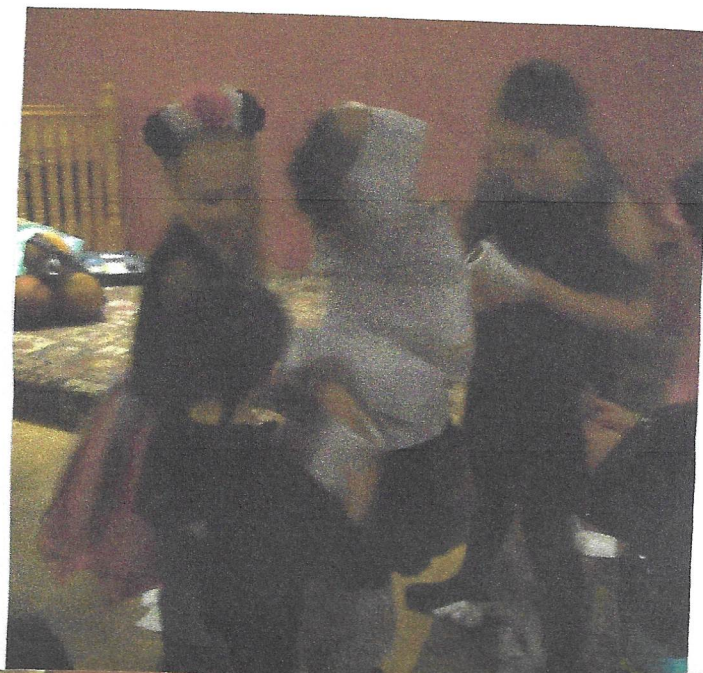
